Weekly Reflection

This Sunday we return back to Ordinary Time, and yet the wedding at Cana has some ties to the Christmas and Epiphany season.

Every Mass we have a preface to the Eucharistic prayers and it changes throughout the year. At this time period we have used the same one for three weeks in a row, which speaks about Christ's triune revelation.

The first is Christ being revealed to the nations through the Magi, then the following week Christ's divine revelation at His baptism, as witnessed by the Holy Spirit and the voice of the Father. The third is Christ revealing His power to His disciples when He turned water into wine.

These few weeks help the transition flow (pun not intended) from a great celebration towards more everyday situations.

Despite the necessity of water, it seems we perceive water as ordinary. Perhaps it has become mundane to our everyday way of life, as compared having the trials to fetch the water from a well several times a day.

In Judaism, water represents the law (Torah). The mindset is because water sits in the lowly places; therefore, one must be humble to reach it.

In the same traditions of our Jewish brethren, wine often represents joy. Thus, the representation of our gospel has the mundane precepts of the law becoming joyous!

When we understand the depth of God's love and the love we should share with one another, then all those details of the law seem to fade into the joy of love.
