### *Weekly Reflection*

Our readings today reflect on hope and trust. So what is the difference?

The dictionary defines hope as a feeling of expectation and a desire for a certain thing to happen. For example, "I hope I pass the test" or "I hope she will go out with me."

Trust, on the other hand, is a firm belief in the reliability, truth, ability, or strength of some one or something. Based on the previous examples, we have, "I'm confident that I passed the test" or "We're going on a date as soon as I ask her out."

Indeed, the trust examples could conceivably be just another form of hope with a mask of confidence to hide insecurities.

Yet, with our Lord and Savior, we can be confident because there is a history of His love, support, guidance, grace, and mercy.

Of course, questions may arise because we learn about the reliability of God with other people, not necessarily with ourselves.

This is where we have to learn to recognize God in our own lives, especially in the little things that occur. It is through this recognition that we find how much the Lord truly loves us.

When we can see Him in the little things, we have fewer questions or doubts about the bigger things of life. Thus, our confidence grows in this wonderful relationship, which helps deepen our faith.

Keep your eyes on the promises the Lord has given and trust that through whatever your journey brings, the Lord is faithful to the end. This we can truly trust!
