Weekly Reflection

Today we celebrate the Presentation of the Lord, which commemorates the presentation of Jesus at the Temple by Mary and Joseph.

This feast is also known as Candlemas and The Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

According to Leviticus 12, "A woman who becomes pregnant and gives birth to a son will be ceremonially unclean for seven days, just as she is unclean during her monthly period. On the eighth day the boy is to be circumcised. Then the woman must wait thirty-three days to be purified from her bleeding. She must not touch anything sacred or go to the sanctuary until the days of her purification are over."

Today is the fortieth day since Christ's birth, and the time for Mary and Joseph to bring Jesus to the Temple. It is often considered the end of the Christmas-Epiphany season.

For some Christian denominations, it is a time to bring candles to their local church, where they are blessed and then used for the rest of the year.

These blessed candles serve as a representation of Jesus Christ, who is the Light of the world (see John 1).

Take some time to reflect on the Light and know it is by the Light that we can see, both in the material world as well as the spiritual realm.

Let us give honor, praise and glory to Jesus Christ, the only begotten Son of the Father, who made heaven and earth.
