Weekly Reflection

I remember hearing in my childhood years the adage, "the straw that broke the camel's back."

It would seem that persistent problems or occurrences can overburden each of us, and when feeling the strain of those historical items, any new occurrences added, no matter how small, could cause a person to go over their threshold.

At that point we may say something that cannot be unsaid, or we do something that cannot be undone.

This not the point we desire to experience because we can hurt someone we love, or cause a reaction from another person where we become the victim of pain. Either situation can cause us to carry a heavy burden of guilt or anger.

Place that in context to Christ's message in Matthew 16:24-26, "If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me. For whoever would save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it. For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world and forfeits his soul? Or what shall a man give in return for his soul?"

We know the cross is heavy, and it may take all our strength. So why would we want additional burdens to carry?

Release those burdens that can hurt others, and keep those which can help us to be closer to our Lord by forgiving one another, including our enemies.
