Weekly Reflection

Over the years, we encounter times when our elderly loved ones speak about the inheritances to be left for us.

It's usually an uncomfortable time because we don't want to think about their nearing deaths.

Yet, there have been occasions these same loved ones give the inheritance while they still live because they know their wishes are set into motion.

Today's readings cover the whole spectrum of inheritances given while still living and after death.

The LORD promised Abraham land for him and his descendants, but no death is required to receive this gift because the LORD fulfilled it soon after promising.

However, there is a portion of this promise that pertains to the kingdom that will come, and that will include past generations living in the promised land.

There is also the inheritance that St. Paul writes about by imitating our Lord and Savior. Paul shares - ***"He will change our lowly body to conform with his glorified body."***

The irony in this promise is that for us to receive this inheritance, we are the ones who will pass from this life, thus imitating what Christ Jesus went through from life, to death, and then to everlasting life.
