Weekly Reflection

This week we can put up a sign that says, "Lost and Found" because we are reminded about the parable of the Prodigal Son. It is actually the third of the parables that comes from Luke 15.

The first two parables are very short. The first is about leaving ninety –nine sheep in the field to search for the one lost sheep. When it's found, the owner rejoices!

The second is a woman who lost a silver coin, and diligently seeks to find it. When she does, she contacts her friends to come celebrate with her that it was found.

We know we lose things because we are aware that we possessed it previously. So let us be sure to recognize the Lord gave us salvation and the forgiveness of sins.

This is a very special gift that we possess, and its security seems to work differently than we often would imagine.

Normally, we would place things special to us in safe location around the house or in a safety deposit box.

Yet, for us to keep it secure, we need to give it to others. By doing so, we are actually placing this special treasure in heaven where it cannot be damaged or taken.

God set the standard for forgiveness through Jesus Christ. What we give to others is the measure compared to that standard. This is important because the measure we give is the measure we shall receive (Luke 6:38).

The more we share in forgiveness, the more we find the forgiveness God has given to us.
