# Prayers of the Faithful Response

Hear us, Lord, and have mercy.

### Weekly Reflection

Our first reading reminds us that it is the Lord who is our Savior, and that He fulfills what He promises. In return should remember to give thanks and praise.

In our second reading, we find a simple instruction, *"if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved."* 

How difficult is it to confess aloud that Jesus is Lord? We attend Mass frequently where we give praise and worship to God, so that is should be truly easy...right?

Believing in your heart that God raised Jesus from the dead should also be quite simple for the same reason.

Yet, here are two pieces that cause many people to struggle. The first is our actions speak quite clearly what we truly believe in our hearts. Are our actions consistent to that claim?

The second challenge is facing temptations. This is what we found Jesus doing in our gospel passage today.

Keep in mind that Jesus fasted for forty days, so He was quite weakened and vulnerable. Yet, Jesus held firm in words and actions in His belief and trust in God.

How often do we find ourselves falling short because we are so tired, or having a bad day?

The Lord is not looking to shame us, but to encourage us to take that extra step to grow in faith. He knows it takes time, but He wants us to begin that journey.
