### **Weekly Reflection**

In our first reading, Amalek waged war against Israel. While Moses kept his arms raised to honor the Lord, Israel had the advantage, but when his arms were down, Amalek had the better of the battle.

The same can be found in the spiritual battles that rage in our personal lives. When we pray and honor the Lord, we can find His support from our prayers and the reading of His Holy Word.

As St. Paul writes: *"...from infancy you have known the sacred Scriptures, which are capable of giving you wisdom for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful for teaching, for refutation, for correction, and for training in righteousness so that one who belongs to God may be competent, equipped for every good work...be persistent whether it is convenient or inconvenient; convince, reprimand, encourage through all patience and teaching."*

Be patient and persistent, as the widow in our gospel reading was to the dishonest judge as she sought to have a just decision.

Our Lord is honest, faithful, and merciful. So, let us give praise, glory, and honor to the Lord Most High every day and for everything!

God knows our needs and has provided for us. Yet, there are times in our lives when we encounter greater challenges that require further assistance.

The Lord listens to those who are humble of heart and honors Him. In return He will raise us up and bring honor to us through His love.
