Weekly Reflection

That was written by St. Paul, who did what he could to stop the spread of the gospel.

Fortunately, it is the Lord who will be judge over all things; therefore, our hope rests upon God. This hope is because of the sacrifice Jesus Christ gave for all, despite our faults.

Remember that God still loves us and wants us to be with Him for all eternity. We need to make that choice and then do our best in words and deeds showing that desire.

So, let us be thankful to God, and then try to imitate Christ, as the saints have done before us. And finally, let us remember those souls who have gone ahead that need our love and prayers.
