Weekly Reflection

We are approaching that time again for Lent. In fact, we begin our Pre-Lent liturgies today and it will continue for the next two Sundays.

Our readings for this time period are taken from the sixth, seventh, and eighth Sundays of ordinary time to help us prepare spiritually for the long journey of Lent.

This is a good time to start reflecting on some of the Lenten observations of fasting during Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all Fridays throughout Lent.

A traditional choice during Lent is to give something up. Unfortunately, after Lent everything goes back to normal. So, hopefully I can encourage you to consider making life changing choices instead of going back to the food or habit that you originally gave up.

We should be seeking ways to help ourselves become a better person in mind, body, and spirit.

Although it would be nice to “fix” all our problems at once, it is not a realistic goal and it would be doomed to failure, which is not very encouraging at all.

Therefore, find that one item that has been gnawing at you and make that your goal for your journey of Lent. For example, saying prayers every day not only leads to more time with our Lord and Savior, it helps improve our relationship with Him. By the time Lent ends that closeness becomes something you may wish to keep...and that's a good thing.
