Weekly Reflection

Palm Sunday begins the journey of Holy Week when we find the roller coaster ride filled with hopes, fears, and victory.

Yet, I must confess, I have never been a fan of encountering the Passion of Jesus on Palm Sunday and then again on Good Friday.

Christ's Passion is an important moment to understand human frailty and how Jesus endured so much for our sake. This rush to His Passion seems to undermine what the people experienced.

Palm Sunday is the entrance into Jerusalem. It is not the first time Jesus entered Jerusalem for Passover, but it is the time when the people saw Him as the Messiah and had great expectations they will finally be free from their oppressor.

This excitement was not for a moment,; it grew as the week continued. Imagine the great excitement of the promised Messiah in their midst, and then learning how Jesus chased the money changers out from the Temple area. Everything seemed ripe for the Messianic prophecies to be fulfilled.

Then things seemed to have become a bit quiet. Perhaps a tactical move surrounding the Passover celebration that speaks of their liberation from oppression.

Suddenly, news breaks forth that Jesus was arrested. This is not what the people were expecting. Some become afraid, while others become angry.

What a moment for the leadership to seize the opportunity for Jesus to die so they can be saved! Yet, so close were they to the truth, but they could not see the greater salvation was for the whole world and not just a few people.
