Weekly Reflection

One of the earliest things we learn about our faith is to make the sign of the cross as we recite those words. When we baptize, we do so in the name of the Holy Trinity.

We close some prayers with “we ask this in the name of Jesus, Your Son, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God for ever and ever.”

We say these things, but do we really understand them?

In our human thinking we perceive each person as an individual with his or her own personalities with choices through free will.

Although this is true for couples as well, something happens with those couples. Often there is a change that works towards a common goal. This can be seen when a child tries to get different answers from his parents so he has permission for what he wants.

Yet, in the relationship of the Holy Trinity, the analogy of the couple pales in comparison because the bond of the Holy Trinity is so great and perfect that we have a difficult time understanding it without the flaws we see in humanity.

Is it any wonder that this remains one of the mysteries of our faith? But we do not need to solve the mystery; we just need to know the Lord will be with us to the end because He loves us.
