### ***Weekly Reflection***

Today we celebrate the Word of God. It's easy to relate the Word of God to the reading of the bible, but the Word is also Christ (see John 1).

Why is Jesus the Word of God? One answer is that Jesus exemplifies all that God calls us to do.

Another answer takes us back to the time when creation began. To illustrate, begin by closing your eyes (after you finish reading what to do). Imagine total emptiness in the dark. Not despair, just emptiness.

Then in an instant, a burst of light emerges from a central location as it stretches across the empty space. That moment is when the Light of God emanated, giving birth to all creation. It is the moment when the Father spoke and His Word became alive!

That is probably the moment that Jesus speaks about in John 17:5, "And now, Father, glorify me in your presence with the glory I had with you before the world began."

This Word, this Light is the glorified Son of God before He humbled Himself to be like us and born through the virgin and became man where He led us with teachings of love, knowledge, and actions to be imitators of Himself.

When you read the bible, think about all that happened to bring this inspired word of God before your very eyes; knowing that the Word of God is written to read and was made flesh so we may one day see and share in His glory, too.
