Weekly Reflection

In today's gospel Jesus says, "*Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me, and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me*" (Mt 10: 37).

Sometimes studying scripture is easy when the meaning is plain. However, there are times when we have to look more deeply, including at things that are not stated.

For example, we already know we are to love the Lord our God with all our heart, mind and soul (Dt 6:5; Mt 22:37; Lk 10:27). In many ways we know that our love can be shared among others, with some more dear to us than others.

Yet, in today's gospel, we do not find mention about husband and wife. Is it because there is an assumption that it should be included, does it mean there is an exception, or something else?

Sometimes such questions are needed to go beyond assumptions and to seek a deeper understanding. In this case, we know scripture tells us the two shall become one (Gn 2:24). Therefore, that unity can either enhance our love for God, or inhibit that love.

When it enhances, then the two are working well together putting God in their lives and marriage while being a great example to others. When it inhibits that love for God, there are often conflicts between spouses, spilling outward toward others.

Therefore, please pray that all marriages will enhance the love for God and be an example of hospitality of love and life.
