Weekly Reflection

It seems we are in a time period of our liturgies to face mystery upon mystery.

First we reach the Easter season with the resurrection of Christ after all He suffered until death. Then we see Him ascend, followed by the receiving of the Holy Spirit and the public birth of the Church in Pentecost, and then the mystery of the Holy Trinity.

Today we are celebrating Corpus Christi, the Body and Blood of Christ and next week will be the Word of God.

Each of these moments, or mysteries, actually helps us grow in our faith if we are able to see how it all ties together. It helps to see beyond the physical realm towards the spiritual.

Don't be misled to believe that spiritual things are symbolic things; they are very different. Symbolism has a representation to something else. For example, our nation's flag represents the freedom we share. We cannot wrap ourselves in the American flag in another country and expect the same freedoms we experience here.

In contrast, God is Spirit and He is real. We can wrap ourselves in God's presence and He is the same everywhere. We can even talk with Him to share our joys and miseries.

Through the Body and Blood we receive in the Eucharist we do more than just wrap ourselves; we find an intimate God waiting to embrace us.
