Weekly Reflection

When I was much younger, I played little league baseball for several years, and became relatively good in the eyes of some. I was rather comfortable playing, encouraging my teammates, and becoming reliable for hitting the ball to drive in runs or getting on base.

My coaches were good in terms of teaching basics and promoting values. I remember them emphasizing that it was important to “meet” the ball, and not to “kill” it.

This elemental behavior is what helped me in the successes playing baseball, whether on a team or during gym class.

I remember my gym teacher would be the pitcher for both teams, and I usually managed well with my hits and runs. Yet, one day he decided to let my classmate to pitch.

As I took the bat and walked over to home plate, she would call to her teammates to back up. This actually encouraged me to drive that ball further than before. With every reasonable pitch I would swing to kill that ball...but I only managed to strike myself out.

I quickly realized my error and became disappointed in myself because I let my emotions take control and ignored the basic element that brought me much success in just meeting the ball.

Jesus sowed seeds to teach us basic elements of love and forgiveness for the Kingdom of God. We know and understand these, but how often do we ignore them when our emotions take control?
